In this workshop we will take a look at the array of digital tools at our disposal in the classroom and how these tools can be integrated to support teaching and learning. These are some of the digital tools that you, as a teacher, and your English learners might have: an interactive whiteboard, a computer, a data projector, Internet connection, mobile phones and tablets. We will look at different scenarios and how these tools can instill creativity and promote interaction and language practice. Although I will refer sometimes to different tasks that the learners may do independently outside the school setting, my main focus will be on the integration of these tools for group dynamics in the classroom. In particular, we will be exploring some apps for mobile devices, some Web 2.0 tools, Google, Twitter, webcams and photo cameras. I hope that I can surprise you with some teaching ideas that you can add to your repertoire!
